Definition

n. A noun that denotes a material or tangible object or phenomenon; it is perceivable by the senses.

Example Sentence

The word 'apple' is an example of a **concrete noun** because it refers to something you can see and touch.

Concrete nouns like 'tree' and 'car' represent objects that exist in the physical world.
