

deviate *(de-vi-ate)*

Definition

v. 1 to turn away from a direct course or one that has already been set; 2 to stray from typical or accepted behavior.

Example Sentence

We tried to get our teacher to **deviate** from her boring lesson.

deflect; stray; swerve; vary; veer

go straight; keep; stay

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
