Definition

n. A chemical reaction that absorbs energy from its surroundings, usually in the form of heat.

Example Sentence

Photosynthesis is an example of an **endothermic reaction** because it absorbs sunlight to produce energy.

More Example Sentences

The melting of ice is an **endothermic reaction** as it requires heat to change from solid to liquid.
