

exponential notation *(ex-po-nen-tial-no-ta-tion)*

Definition

n. a mathematical method for writing numbers using powers of ten, often used to express very large or very small numbers compactly.

Example Sentence

In **exponential notation**, the number 300 can be written as 3×10^2 .

Exponential notation simplifies the process of handling extremely large numbers in calculations.
