## Definition

v. 1 to come to a broad idea about something after considering particular facts; 2 to make useful to a wide range of situations or ideas; Chiefly British.

## Example Sentence

The teacher **generalised** some rules for behavior at school.

make a sweeping assumption; statement; conclude

## Antonyms

specifize
