

interrogating (*in-ter-ro-gat-ing*)

Definition

v. asking questions of someone, especially a suspect or a prisoner, closely, aggressively, or formally.

Example Sentence

The detective spent hours **interrogating** the suspect to uncover the truth.

Interrogating witnesses was a crucial part of the investigation process.
