

intransitive *(in-tran-si-tive)*

Definition

n. a verb or verb construction that does not take an object; adj. designating a verb that does not require or cannot take a direct object

Example Sentence

Run and sleep are both **intransitive** verbs.

verb not need an object; no direct object; not requiring a direct object
