Definition

n. a wooden warship of the 19th century that is plated with iron or steel armor; adj. 1 sheathed in iron plates for protection; 2 very rigid or exacting; inflexible

Example Sentence

The bullets bounced off the **ironclad**. OR The contract was **ironclad**.
