## Definition

n. Evidence that does not relate to or have any bearing on the matter at hand.

## Example Sentence

The lawyer objected to the introduction of **irrelevant evidence** during the trial.

The judge instructed the jury to disregard the **irrelevant evidence** presented earlier.

## Synonyms

unrelated information; immaterial evidence;  
extraneous details

## Antonyms

relevant evidence; pertinent information; material  
evidence
