

# lophophore *(loph-o-phore)*

## Definition

n. 1 the ring of ciliated tentacles encircling the mouth of a bryozoan or phoronid; 2 a similar organ in a brachiopod composed of two ciliated spirally coiled tentacles

A **lophophore** is often horsehoe-shaped or coiled.
