Definition

v. past tense of maim; to wound or injure someone so that part of the body is permanently damaged.

Example Sentence

Many soldiers were **maimed** in the war.

More Example Sentences

During the battle, many soldiers were **maimed**, suffering serious injuries.

healed; restored; unhurt
