Definition

v. 1 keep busy with 2 to live in 3 be present in; be inside of 4 to take over by force

Example Sentence

The enemy is **occupying** the hill.

Synonyms

amuse; busy; engage; inhabit; live in; taking over

Antonyms

be inactive; be lazy; idle; relinquish
