

right atrium *(right-a-tri-um)*

Definition

n. The right upper chamber of the heart that receives deoxygenated blood from the body through the venae cavae and pumps it into the right ventricle.

Example Sentence

The **right atrium** plays a crucial role in the circulatory system by receiving blood from the body.

During the cardiac cycle, the **right atrium** contracts to push blood into the right ventricle.
