Definition

adj. noisy and disorderly. rowdy people can be loud and disruptive.

Example Sentence

She is more reserved than her **rowdy** brother. OR Go away you **rowdy**.

More Example Sentences

At the party the crowd became **rowdy** quickly.

loud; boisterous; unruly

Antonyms

quiet; calm; peaceful
