Definition

v. Past tense of 'shy'; to start suddenly aside in fright at an object, noise, or movement.

Example Sentence

The horse **shied** at the sudden movement in the bushes.

He **shied** away from the spotlight, preferring to work behind the scenes.

flinched; recoiled; startled

Antonyms

confronted; faced; approached
