Instructions: Say the word, trace it, then write it on your own.


Example Sentence

The blind man was **unsighted**.

SAY IT!
unsighted

TRACE IT!
unsighted

WRITE IT!
unsighted



Tracing guide for the word "unsighted". The word is written on a set of three horizontal lines (top, middle, bottom).
